

MANDRARE RIVER CAMP

The camp sits on the banks of the Mandrare River nestled under the shade of Tamarind Trees. The river is the lifeblood of the region and sustains the close by Antandroy village of Ifotaka and its sacred ancestral forests.

THE TENTS

Our nine en-suite tents are located in the sheltering shade of tamarind trees with a view over the tranquil waters of the Mandrare River up onto the sacred mountains behind.

- Four poster king-size bed, mosquito net & fan
- Wardrobe and dressing table
- Bedside tables and lights, 24 hour solar lighting and hot water
- A fully equipped bathroom with hot water
- Luggage compartment

GETTING THERE

Get there by schedule charter flight directly to the camp or the daily Tsaradia service to Fort Dauphin. Mandrare is a 3 hrs drive from Fort Dauphin with our private shuttle service.

Schedule charter flights operate on **Mondays** and **Fridays** between mid-May and mid-November 2025 as follows:

Antananarivo - Mandrare River Camp (07:00 am - 9:30 am)

Mandrare River Camp - Antananarivo (10:00 am - 13:30) *Includes a 30 min stop in Fort Dauphin for refuelling.*

SEASONS

CAMP CLOSED: 10 January - 24 March

GREEN SEASON: 25 March - 20 June / 21 November - 9 January

HIGH SEASON: 21 June - 31 August / 1 - 20 November

PEAK SEASON: 1 September - 31 October.

CLIMATE

May to July - dry with temperatures around 20°. From Aug till Apr up to 30° C with very few rainy days.

CHILDREN

Children under the age of 4 stay for free. Children under 16, who stay with their parents get 50 % off the rate. We offer child friendly menus.



NAMOROKA TSINGY CAMP

Found in the North Western Madagascar the park is the Region of Boeny 100kms South West from the Regional Capital of Mahajunga (Majunga). Namoroka National Park was first formed as a strict reserve in 1927 and became a nature reserve in 1966 before officially becoming a National Park. It is largely unexplored by both scientists and tourists with only a handful of expeditions to date. There is no formal accommodation in or around the park, apart from Namoroka Tsingy Camp. In the last five years there been only a handful of visitors and this is one of the remotest unexplored places in Madagascar.

THE TENTS

Our seven en-suite tents are located on the edge of the Tsingy overlooking riverine forest.

Get there by schedule charter flight to Soalala and 2:30 hrs drive

Schedule charter flights operate on **Tuesdays** and **Saturdays** between mid-May and mid-November 2025 as follows:

Antananarivo – Soalala (08:00 am – 9:30 am)

Soalala – Antananarivo (10:00 am – 11:30)

SEASONS

OPEN: 15th May – 10th November

CLOSED: 11th November – 14th May

CLIMATE

The tropical Western Madagascar is hot year-round with a distinct rainy season. Typically the area has no rainfall between May and October and then the main rainy period is January to March. The 'winter' months of June to August have cooler evenings where a light sweater may be required, but daytime temperatures are always in the high 20's or low 30's in winter.
